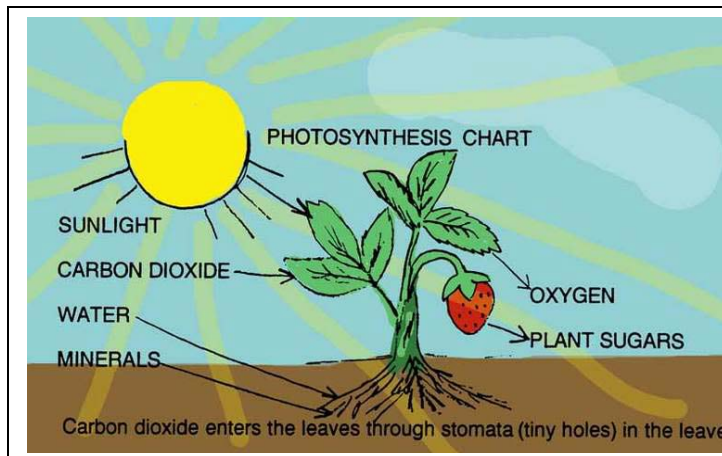


Greetings and the latest update from Bradley:

So, try and give your plants as much sunlight during the day as possible and enjoy your gardens and the fruits of your labor!

Spring Break is a great time to plant your strawberries. They can be used as rows in the garden, borders in flower beds, patio potted plants or hanging baskets. Spring Crop varieties will produce in the late Spring to early Summer. Ever-bearing varieties will produce a small Spring crop and bear heaviest in late Summer – early Fall. Day neutral ever-bearing will bear fruit until the frost and shorter days of Fall will not effect your fruit production as they are neutral to day length.
