





**Cultural Tips For The Successful Grower**  
**Quinault**

**Quinault** - Washington State Release. Recommended for Alaska, the Pacific Northwest and the Midwest. Does poorly in the South and not suitable for California. Large berry, firm and deep red with good flavor. Good for fresh eating, desserts, and preserves. Not recommended for freezing. High yielding, vigorous plants produce many runners, susceptible to mildew. Fruit too soft for fruit stands sales but excellent for pick your own and home gardens.



**Planting Instructions:** - In the home garden strawberries make an excellent ground cover. No soil preparation is necessary if the flower bed is mulched with bark dust, saw dust, etc. Simply dig the plant in leaving the crown exposed at ground level. Never plant strawberries to a depth where the crown is buried. Avoid wadding the roots in the planting hole.
