





## Cultural Tips For The Successful Grower Rainier

**Rainier** - Washington State Release. A very tough virus tolerant plant. Best home garden variety from standpoint of fruit quality and disease resistance. Extremely vigorous grower with large floppy leaves that are ornamentally attractive. The berry is medium to large in size and conic in shape. A fairly soft berry, Rainier is excellent for fresh eating as well as processing.



**Planting Instructions:** - In the home garden strawberries make an excellent ground cover. No soil preparation is necessary if the flower bed is mulched with bark dust, saw dust, etc. Simply dig the plant in leaving the crown exposed at ground level. Never plant strawberries to a depth where the crown is buried. Avoid wadding the roots in the planting hole.
